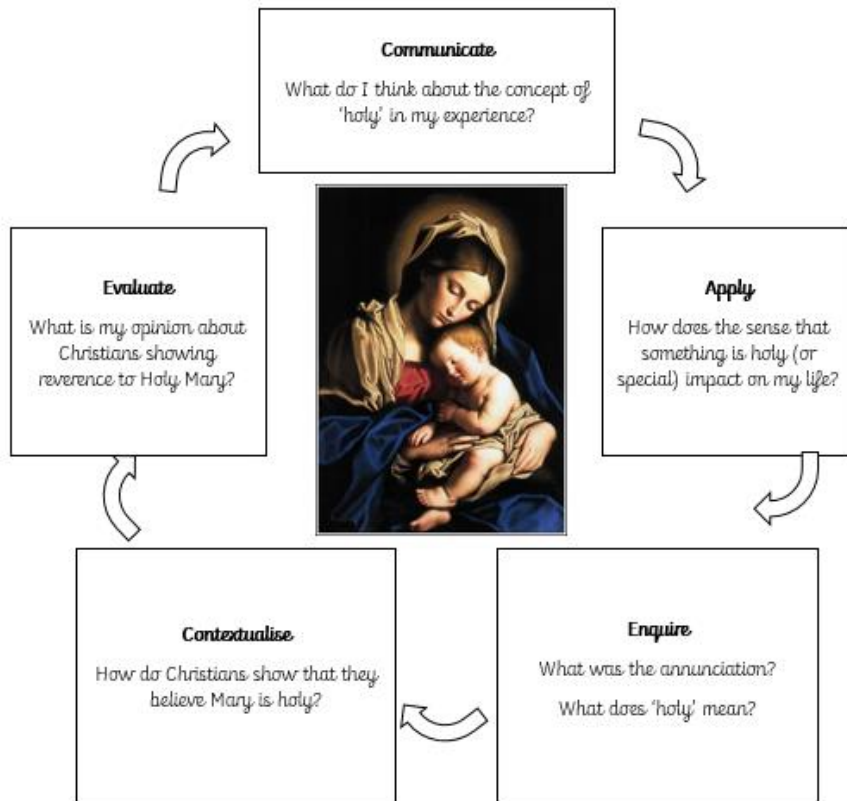


RE Knowledge Organiser – Year 4 Autumn term 1b

Concept: Holy



Key knowledge

- In Christianity Mary is the mother of Jesus, she is considered holy and the course of her life changed dramatically following the annunciation.
- Catholics show particular reverence to Mary and have a special prayer called a 'Hail Mary'
- Hindus worship at their shrine every day when they practice Puja

annunciation	The announcement of the Incarnation by the angel Gabriel to Mary	devotion	Love and religious worship for someone	Puja	The act of worship in Hinduism
New testament	The second part of the Christian Bible about the life of Jesus.	reverence	Deep respect for someone or something.	Ganesha	The elephant-headed Hindu god of beginnings
