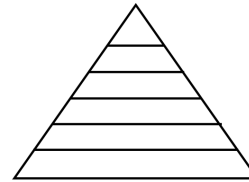

Key Vocabulary	
Anachronistic	Belonging to a period other than the one being portrayed
Significance	Being of special importance to a people/group of peoples
Hierarchy	A ranking of people based on power or status
Civilisation	A group of people with their own languages and way of life
Primary source	A physical artefact made during the time in history.
Secondary source	An image, description or writing about a piece of evidence that someone else has created
