Key Vocabulary	
Sketch	Term used to roughly outline the shape of a drawing.
Draft	The versions or practices used before a final piece.
Reference Image	The image, usually a photo, that serves as a starting point to a piece.
Collage	The process of layering pieces of material on top of each other to create an image
PVA Glue	Polyvinyl Acetate glue is a plastic based glue that dries clear
Layout	The structure that a piece of work is organised
Foreground	The area of an image closest to the viewer. (Lower Third)
Mid-ground	The area of an image just behind the foreground (Mid Third)
Background	The area furthest from the viewer (Upper Third)
