Dear Parents and Carers,

I was welcoming children and families to school last week at the start of the school day, when I was stopped by a parent who shared with me how lovely it was to see so many smiling faces making their way into school.

Later that morning, I was out on break duty and it was a typical fun, active and not-so-quiet place to be as children engaged in multiple games of Four Square, 9 Square and basketball. On the top playground, children were using the playground markings games to enjoy running races and down in the lower playground a class were merrily playing on the trim trail. There was a place of 'calm' sanctuary in our leafy Quiet Area, where several children were relaxing in the leafy shade, on our colourful benches.

At lunchtime, we were joined by the sports coaches from CM Sports, who assist our lunchtimes on Tuesdays and Thursdays. We hope that they will soon be training up a group of Sports/Play Leaders, who will help facilitate lunchtime play in the near future.

We also hope to start up some quiet play, outside board games for those who might prefer quieter and calmer pursuits during the lunchtime break. If you have any unwanted, robust board games that would withstand being played outdoors in a variety of seasons, then please let us know, as they would help us get this new initiative started.

The Sports Coaches then stay with us for the afternoon (on Tuesdays and Thursdays) and lead classes across the school in additional Games sessions, much like we do for Outdoor Learning. This means that your child will receive high quality sports coaching in a range of new sports, across the year, as well as their usual (and equally high quality) Games and PE lessons.

We are also keen to compete in as many of the local tournaments and festivals as we can this year. CM Sports will help us train the various groups and teams, so that they are ready to represent the school with PRIDE.

Speaking of representing the school with PRIDE, the Cross Country season started up on Portsdown Hill on Friday. The team did a cracking job, with fantastic performances from both the boys and girls teams respectively. We hope to hold trials for Years 4, 5 and 6 next week, at afternoon breaks on Tuesday and Wednesday. The children will be told about this on Monday. All they need is a pair of trainers and a 'never give up' attitude! We are likely to run the club at afternoon breaks, so that even if your child might not be involved in the races, they can come out for a friendly 'fun run' of sorts, to keep fit and feel part of an important aspect of Denmead Juniors.

In my first year, we introduced the fantastic Outdoor Learning into the curriculum, the next year we focussed on giving children high quality musical opportunities, through additional staff training and the introduction











of the Listen2Me music tuition across all classes, led by Hampshire Music specialists. This year, we hope to enhance our sporting opportunities for children across the school in the curriculum and also in our extra-curricular offer and playtimes.

By further enhancing our provision in this way, I am sure we will continue to have many smiling faces coming into school each day!
