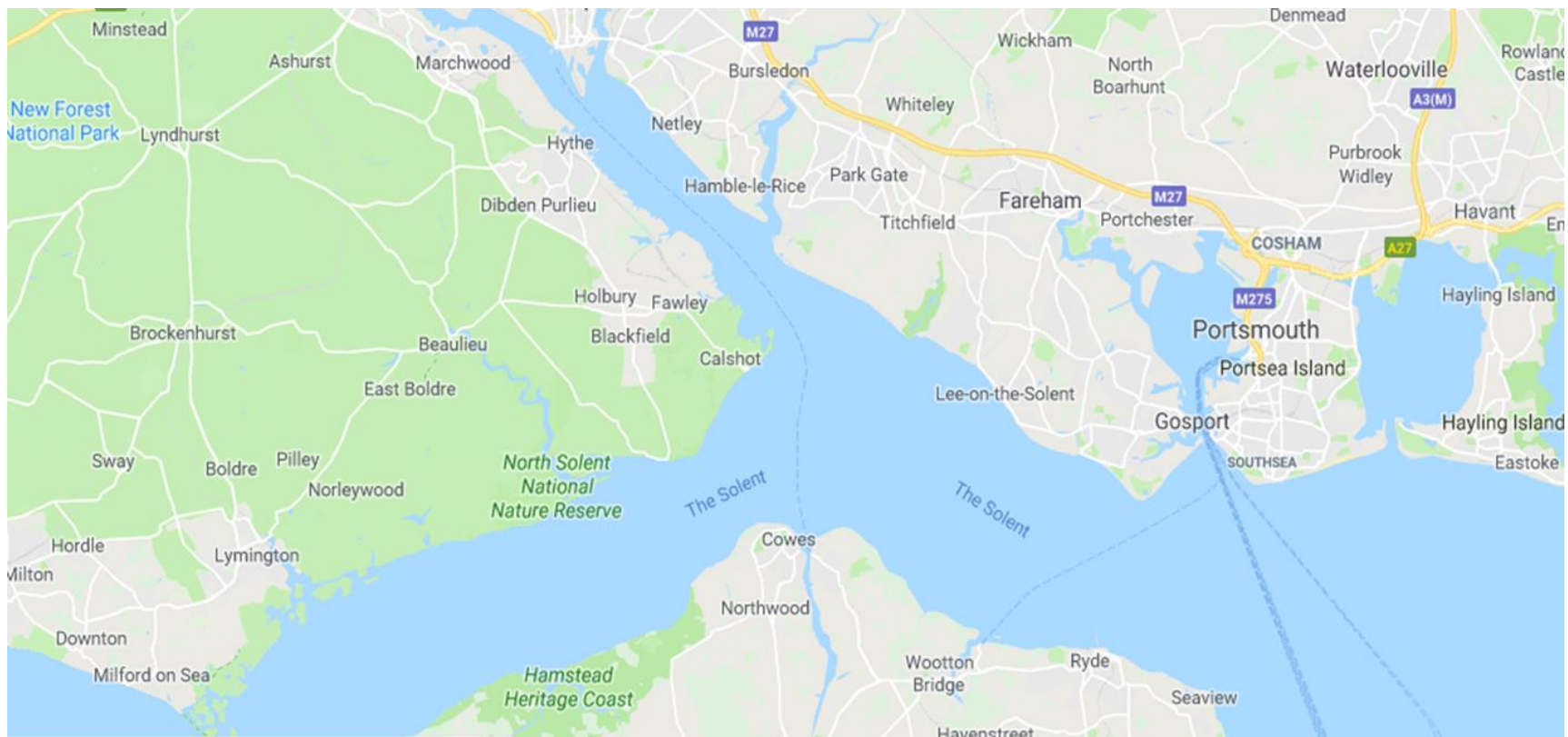

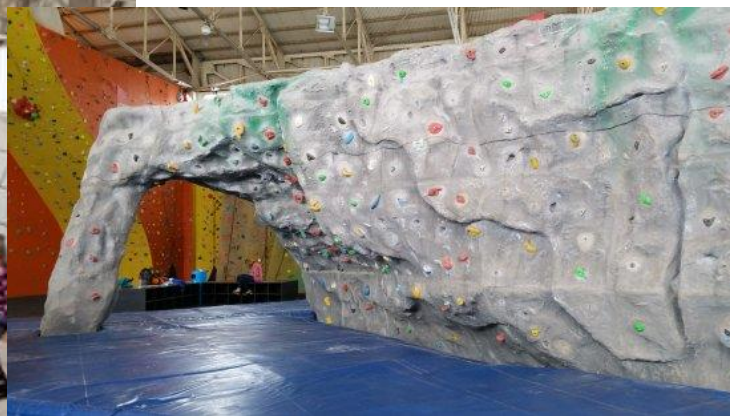
Drop Off
