## Upper school Winchester school trip – Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March 2020

We're writing to tell you about an exciting trip we have organised later this half term to visit Winchester Cathedral and The Great Hall to support our History and RE topic of Power.

We will leave after normal 8.45am registration and expect to arrive back to school by 3.30pm for usual going home time. During the day, the children will visit both the Cathedral, the Great Hall and complete a walking tour of Winchester. We will be having lunch in the Winchester Cathedral education centre.

Your child will need to wear full school uniform for this trip and bring a water bottle and packed lunch. We will be having lunch in the Winchester Cathedral education centre however, your child will require a warm coat, comfortable shoes - which may include sensible trainers - for walking in and a ruck sack to put their coat or jumpers in when inside. If you would like your child to be supplied with a school packed lunch (cheese roll, crunchy vegetable sticks, biscuit and a drink) please indicate this on the slip overleaf.

It is necessary to ask for a voluntary contribution of £10.75 per child in order to ensure that this trip can take place. This covers the cost of the coach and entrance fees. Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough contributions towards the visit, it may have to be cancelled. Payment should be made via the Scopay App or online [www.scopay.com/denmead-jun](http://www.scopay.com/denmead-jun). If you do not have access to the internet, we can accept cash or cheque made payable to Denmead Junior School. Please send money in an envelope marked with your child's name, class and "Winchester Trip".
