Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

 1. Write 3 different possible names for this chapter of the story.
 2. Draw a picture to show the scene
 3. Write three things that the main character was thinking.

Weekly Spelling Tasks (aim to do 1 per day)

- Practise the year 3/4 spelling list (pdf on website)
- Choose 5 words from the list. Write the meaning of the word and then use the word in a sentence.
