

RE Home Learning: Our World

There are many different religions across the world, can you research the religions followed across the globe and colour the map showing which religion is the most popular in each country?

Create a key to show which colour you have used for each religion.

Different religions worship in different buildings.

Can you make a model of a religious building? You could use any materials you have at home- it could be junk modelled, plasticine, origami, clay, matchsticks, biscuits, cake! Let your imagination run wild!

Take a photo and email it to the home learning address.

Food is used as a symbol in religions across the world. Can you find out about the foods which are important to one religion.

You can present this however you like- maybe a poster or a leaflet. Or you could try to make some of these foods and video or photograph yourself doing it. The choice is yours!

Many religions believe that humans have a responsibility to look after the world in which we live.

How could we, as a school, work to improve the planet and undo some of the damage humans have caused?

Design a poster to share your ideas.

Many world religions use feasts to celebrate special days. Could you plan a feast you would hold to celebrate the end of Lockdown? What would you eat? Why? Would you have any special rituals at your feasts? E.g. would everyone need to wear their pyjamas?

Create a fact file about your celebration feast.

When the world seems a strange place, we need somewhere to quietly reflect. In different faiths, this can be inside places of worship, within nature or in the home.

Where would your ideal place of reflection be? What would it look like? Why is this important to you? Would you have any special objects within it?

Draw and annotate your place of calm reflection.
