<p>Language skills: Watch BBC Bitesize. Create a fact file for your artist of choice, which can be presented in any way. Create your own artwork in the style of your chosen artist. Recreate your own version of one of their famous paintings.</p>
<p>Culture: Find out about a famous festival in Spain (there are lots!!) Write a short report about it, as if you were there. This is to be written in English, but you could include some key Spanish words linked to the festival.</p>	<p>Geography: Locate a famous Spanish landmark on a map of Spain. Take a virtual tour. What do you think of it?
