Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Practise your times tables on Times Table Rockstars.
- Log on to the following website and complete the 5 maths questions set each day (Scroll down to find May). There are 4 different levels – silver is a good place to start but you can decide if you need more or less of a challenge. <https://corbettmathsprimary.com/5-a-day/>
- The answers are there for you too.
- Practise counting forwards and backwards from any given number in 101s.
- Choosing a times table of choice, ask your child to write a rap/song to help them remember the multiplication facts linked to this time table. Can they include the corresponding division facts in their rap/song too?

Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Ask your child to read a chapter from their reading book and discuss the book with them.
- Challenge your child to read something around the house that isn't a book. They can then complete their reading diary following this.
- Read the science text all about Agnes Arber and then answer the questions (both download from our website). The answers are there also for you to check!

Weekly Spelling Tasks (aim to do 1 per day)

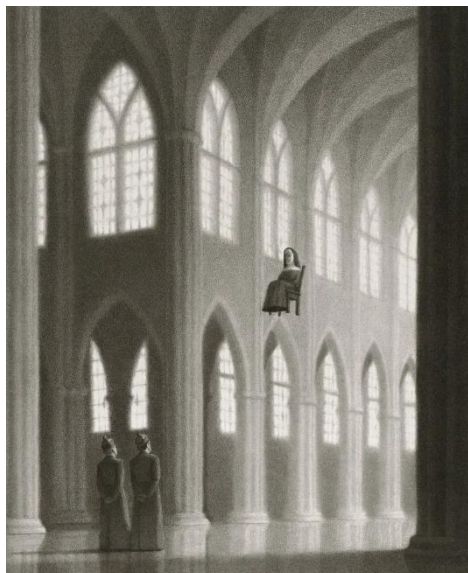
- Practise the year 3/4 spelling list (pdf on website)

Code Words

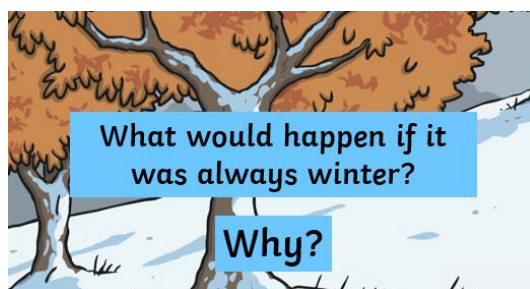
Come up with a code for each letter of the alphabet. Write down your code.
