Maths Tasks

- Please, please, please keep practising your times tables and division facts. There are 4 practise tests of times tables to 12 x 12. Try to complete as many as you can. The last one has some remainders.
- Log on to the website below and complete the 5 maths questions set each. There are 4 different levels – silver is a good place to start but you can decide if you need more or less of a challenge. If you need more to do, then you can scroll down to find further questions

As a rough guide of difficulty level:

- **Challenge 1 and 2** are suitable for ages 5 to 7.
- **Challenge 3 to 6** are suitable for ages 7 to 11.
- **Challenge 7 to 10** are suitable for ages 11 to 15.
