Dear new Year 3 Parents and Carers,

Here we are then, at the end of a memorable school year. I'm sure you will have a mixture of emotions today and some tired children! While the summer holiday break will be much needed for all of us, I hope there will also be an element of excitement as you get closer to September as we look forward to welcoming you into our DJS community.

We'd like to begin this information letter by signposting you to our 'Welcome to Year 3' video on our school website which should complement the information in this letter. Our current risk assessment will remain in force in September, the full details of which can be found on the school website. The main aspects of this risk assessment are that:

- Adults will be required to wear masks when transiting inside the school building
- Regular hand washing and sanitising
- Social distancing when mixing with others beyond your class bubble
- · Enhanced cleaning regime
- High vigilance around identifying early key symptoms as identified by PHE
- Limiting visitors within the school building

THE SCHOOL DAY

- Start & end times; Gates open at 8.30am. The whistles will be blown at 8.40am. School will finish at 3.15pm. The children will stay with the class teacher until we can safely reunite them with yourselves.
- We will continue to operate a one-way system, entering the playground through the single gate accessible via the pathway next to the car park. If you and your child look out for their class teacher, we will help you find their class line, so that the class teacher can lead them into class. You will then exit through the staff car park double gates. Mr Clarke and Mrs Howard will be outside to greet your children each day and also at the end of the day to make sure your children leave safely.
- Lunchtime Lunches will continue as they have for all children this year, with school lunches for those who
 have ordered them, being delivered by class LSAs to the classroom. Hopefully, as we return to a sense of
 normality, we will eventually return to the hall for lunchtimes together. Please remember lunches need to be
 paid for at the Junior School and cost £2.50 each. We have the same menu programme as the Infant school
 and details can be found on our website.
- Snacks If your child would like a snack for break time, please pack this in your child's lunchbox, or in a small plastic bag so that they can access during the morning. Once again, we hope that as things move back to a sense of normality we can re-introduce the school Tuck Shop, where children can purchase healthy snacks.
- What to bring? We would encourage children to bring as small a bag as will accommodate their belongings.
 Many children will just need to bring in their lunchbox, if needed and a plastic reading bag, where their home
 reading book, the reading record and any paper homework can easily be stored and brought easily to and from
 school. We would also encourage your child to bring in a filled WATER bottle, which can be re-filled during the
 school day.











UNIFORM

We want your child to take pride in their appearance and to wear our school uniform to be a member of our school community. From September, DJS school uniform expectations are as follows:

Tops	School sweatshirt/cardigan with the DJS school logo. White shirt/blouse/polo top (optional with school logo).	
Trousers/shorts & dresses/skirts	Grey or black. No leggings/black jeans or tight fashion trousers. In the summer, gingham dresses in blue/white may be worn.	
Socks	Plain white, grey or black	
Shoes	Any sensible black shoes (not sandals, boots or trainers), with closed toe and flat heel.	

(logo items available from the school office or online via SCOPAY once your account is set up)

P.E. kit - On days where the children have timetabled P.E. they should come into school already in their P.E./Games kits. **We will let you know, via a communication on the first two INSET days back in September, which days your child's class will have P.E. and Games.** We participate in a variety of activities indoors and outdoors in most weathers. Please provide your child with the following items:

• Shorts: Black or navy

Polo top: Royal blue with DJS school logo

• Trainers: Sensible plain pair

A pair of socks: White, grey or black
Tracksuit: Black or navy bottoms and top

Other:

- **Hair** Long hair must be tied up with a plain blue, grey, black or white hair tie (not large bows e.g. Jo-jo bows). No extreme haircuts e.g. shavings. No coloured hair dye.
- **Jewellery** For safety measures, we ask that children do not wear jewellery to school. Ear studs and watches are permitted but should be removed for P.E. and Games or covered with their own surgical tape.
- Make up Make up and nail varnish are not permitted and children will be asked to go to the office to have it removed.
