Dear Parents and Carers,

We've enjoyed an exciting and full-on week back to learning after the half-term break.

A number of you will have received your child's results following the dyslexia screening tests that we began before Christmas and completed in January. Hopefully, regardless of result, you will be clearer around your child's level of need and how we might support your child in school and how you might do something similar at home. This was a huge undertaking for the school, but we felt strongly that we conduct these screening tests so that we can all be in a better and clearer position to meet your child's needs.

Mrs Lodge, who is our highly skilled, intervention teacher, is already well trained in this area, but she is also keen to extend her knowledge and understanding so that she can share this further with staff and children alike. She has been recently accepted onto a new course run by the Helen Arkell Dyslexia Charity to extend her knowledge and understanding. The charity does great work across the country and can be a useful portal to understand more about dyslexia and specific learning difficulties (SpLD). Mr Stapleton and the teaching staff, have been sharing reads of children's books that we have recently acquired for our library, to spread the word about new and exciting books and authors. I will signpost these to you in future newsletters, but this another way in which we are trying to 'hook' your children into the enjoyment and pleasure of reading.
