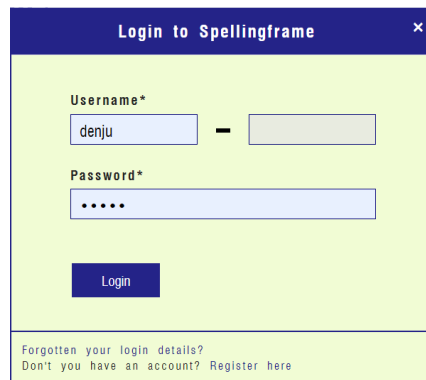
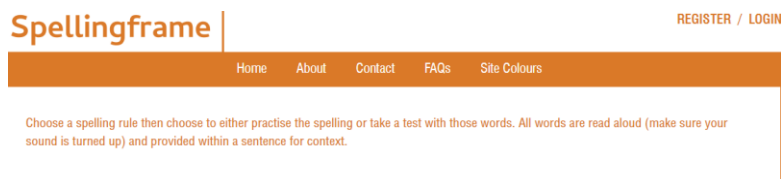

Spelling Frame

As you are aware, we have spent time looking at our spelling provision at Denmead Junior School and changes have now been made. Class teachers are including spelling lessons on a regular basis within their classrooms and children on interventions are receiving a different approach to support their learning.

We are now proud to announce that we have purchased access to Spelling Frame for the children to access in school and at home. Your child will be issued a login over the next few weeks and they will have home learning that is linked to the provision in class. Your child's class teacher will set activities to be completed at home that are linked to the spelling rules that they are focusing on in school.

Dyslexic Font

How can you help at home?

If you feel that you would like to help more at home, then here are some suggestions that you could implement.

- Read with your child and look at the way some of the words are spelt as you read.
- Enjoy a crossword together
- Play word games such as boggle and scrabble
- Investigate the origins of words for example: did you know that the word cupboard comes from the middle English for cup and board, a board in which cups and plates were placed?
